Our goals are simple. Our needs are many.

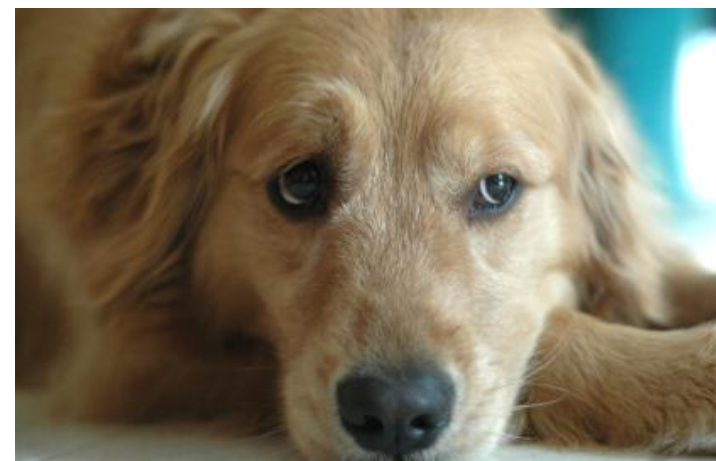
We would like to continue to...
